MAKANA LOCAL MUNICIPALITY WELCOMES THE RETURN OF THE LIVE FESTIVAL

The long-awaited return of the live National Arts Festival (NAF), following a two-year break, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, got off to chilly start on Thursday, 23 June.

Scores of excited locals braved a rainy Thursday evening to witness the much-anticipated live opening of Africa's biggest arts festival in June. The SAPS kicked-off the festivities with a parade in front of the City Hall in High Street on Thursday.

Dignitaries in town for the opening of the NAF included National Assembly Speaker Nosiviwe Mapisa-Nqakula, MEC of Social Development Siphokazi Mani-Lusithi, Outgoing NAF Chairperson Ayanda Mjekula, Deputy Provincial Commissioner Brandi Majikijela, Sarah Baartman District Municipality Mayor Councillor Deon de Vos, Makana Local Municipality Executive Mayor Councillor Yandiswa Vara, Council Speaker Mabhuti Matyumza and more.

Speaking at the opening ceremony the Executive Mayor said Makana Municipality's relationship with the National Arts Festival is unwavering and unshakable. "The economy of this area gets an injection that runs to millions every year from the NAF. Local people are guaranteed jobs every year during the National Arts Festival, local artists get to be exposed and taught new artistic skills through the various workshops that run during the festival and children are treated to variety of kiddies show."

Department of Health Minister, Joe Phaahla, on Wednesday repealed the several COVID-19 regulations relating to the wearing of face masks, gatherings and persons entering the country.

As the Festival dropped its requirements for compulsory wearing of masks, CEO Monica Newton said that the biggest win for the arts and events industries was a much needed return to normal. "Operating at 50% capacity was completely unsustainable for most festivals, theatres and sports events unless they passed the lost revenue onto the customer in the form of higher ticket prices – which would ultimately decrease access to only a small demographic. This good news is an auspicious start to the 2022 National Arts Festival and, we hope, the beginning of a much needed rejuvenation of the arts."

The Sarah Baartman District Municipality (SBDM) in conjunction with the Eastern Cape Provincial Disaster Management Centre (EC-PDMC) a directorate within the Department of Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs (COGTA) hereby advises that due to the Veld Fire Season and prevailing drought conditions no burning or open fires as defined are permitted as follows:

- Makana Municipality as from 1 July 2022 until 31 October 2022
- Kouga – and Koukamma Municipalities as from 1 November 2022 until 28 February 2023;
- Ndlambe as from 1 November 2022 until 28 February 2023;
- Sundays River Valley Municipalities as from 1 November 2022 until 31 January 2023;
- Dr Beyers Naude Municipality as from 1 August 2022 until 31 March 2023;
- Blue Crane Route Municipality as from 1 August 2022 until 30 April 2023

Burning will be allowed under the following strict conditions:

The Chief Fire Officers of the Local Municipalities must approve all burning operations according to their respective burning permit systems.

In the absence of a Chief Fire Officer, the Fire Protection Officer of the local Fire Protection Association must approve all burning operations according to their respective burning permit system and Community Safety By-laws.

Landowners must apply a minimum of seven (7) days prior to burning for pre-approval.

Final approval for burning must be obtained on the day of the proposed burn.

All bordering landowners must be informed of burning operations in terms of the National Veld and Forest Fire Act (Act 101 of 1998) (NVFFA).

The NVFFA places a duty on all landowners to have all precautions in place to prevent a fire from spreading or causing damage.

The public is urged to be extremely vigilant and to report any fires to the Local Municipalities

EXECUTIVE MAYOR'S MESSAGE

Dear residents,

The live National Arts Festival (NAF) returned to Makhanda following a two-year absence.

On behalf of the residents of Makhanda I would like to thank the festival organisers for working around the clock, under challenging circumstances, to ensure that the live festival made a successful return.

Government repealed the remaining COVID-19 regulations on the 24th June 2022, just one day into the National Arts Festival. On the other hand this year's NAF was planned around the COVID-19 regulations which included the mandatory wearing of masks indoors, limitation of gatherings and vaccination proof or PCR negative tests.

As a result when government announced that the regulations would be repealed, quick action needed to be taken to open up venues and make the necessary changes to open up the Festival.

This had an obvious impact on the NAF experience for local people.



Business people who normally put up stalls in High Street and other venues during the Festival were advised in writing not to come to Makhanda to put up their stalls to ensure adherence to the COVID-19 protocols that were in place before the start of the Festival. When the regulations were repealed it was too late to invite stall owners to the Festival.

We would like to express our deepest appreciation to NAF Board led by Chairperson Mr Ayanda Mjekula, NAF CEO Ms Monica Newton and her whole team, the Grahamstown Foundation and Government in general for the continued support of this special festival. As the people of Makhanda we take great pride in hosting the NAF every year and we hope the 50th edition of NAF will take place without any disruption and complications.

We support the Festival fully and we will do our utmost best to ensure that it continues to grow bigger and better every year.

We would also like to congratulate all Makana artists and arts groups that participated in the NAF. This shows that we are truly a city of the arts, not just the hosts.

Congratulations to Dr Mahala on his recent win at the PanSALB Multilingualism Awards for English Literature.

We look forward to an even better 2023 National Arts Festival!!

Eligibility for participation in the scheme is subject to terms and conditions as contained in the debt incentive policy. Applications received for participation in the scheme are to be received within the validity period of each scheme, which will commence on 18th July 2022 and will be terminated on the 31st January 2023.
