**PUBLIC NOTICE – WATER QUALITY**

This notice serves to inform the residents about the water quality that has been noticed at the two points that were recently sampled for routine monitoring.

Points being:

1. Alicedale Water Treatment Works Final Water
2. Nonzwakazi Clinic Kitchen Tap.

Samples indicated the presence of Total coliforms and high Turbidity. High turbidity is the result of high concentration of Iron and total coliform indications are due to a damaged reservoir in Nonzwakazi.

The municipality is addressing the issue of high iron and the reservoir will be repaired in the next 3 months.

The quality of water in the treatment plant is tested on a daily basis and the quality has been consistent in complying with the required standards and monthly sampling and analysis is conducted by Amatola Water Scientific Laboratory.

Residents are therefore assured that the high turbidity experienced in water does not pose a health hazard to humans but at most causes brown stains especially to clothes.

The municipality therefore requests the residents, as a precautionary measure, to hard boil the water before drinking.

Furthermore, residents are requested to allow water to settle before doing laundry to avoid staining of their clothes as that cannot be mitigated by the boiling of water.

Ngaphezu koko, abahlali bayacelwa ukuba bavumele amanzi angcwenge phambi kokuba bavase iimpahla ukuphepha amabala amdaka njengoba engenakuthomalaliswa kukubiliswa kwamanzi.

**OPENBARE KENNISGEWING – WATERKWALITEIT**

Hierdie kennisgewing dien om die inwoners in te lug oor die kwaliteit van die water wat by die twee punte wat was opgemerk het onlangs getoets vir roetine monitering.

Wys dat:

1. Alicedale Watersuiweringswerke Finale Water
2. Nonzwakazi Clinic Kombuis kraan.

Monsters dui op die teenwoordigheid van Totaal kolivorme en hoë Turbidity. Hoë troebelheid is die resultate van 'n hoë konsentrasie van yster en totale kolivorme aanduidings is te danke aan beskadigde reservoir in Nonzwakazi.

Die munisipaliteit verkryk die kwessie van 'n hoë yster en die reservoir sal in die volgende 3 maande herstel gedoen word.

Die gehalte van die water in die behandeling plant is getoets op 'n daaglikse basis en die gehalte konsekwent in ooreenstemming met die vereiste standaarde en maandelikse monsterneming en analise is uitgevoer deur Amatola Water Scientific Laboratory.

Inwoners word dis verseker dat die hoë troebelheid ervarings in die water 'n gesondheids gevaar vir die mens nie inhou maar by die meeste veroorsaak bruin vlekke veral klere.

Die munisipaliteit dis versoek die inwoners, as 'n voorsorg maatreël om hard Kook die water voordat dit gedrink.

Verder word inwoners versoek om toe te laat water op te los voordat jy wasgoed te kleuring van hul klere te vermy wat nie kan versag word deur die kokende water.
