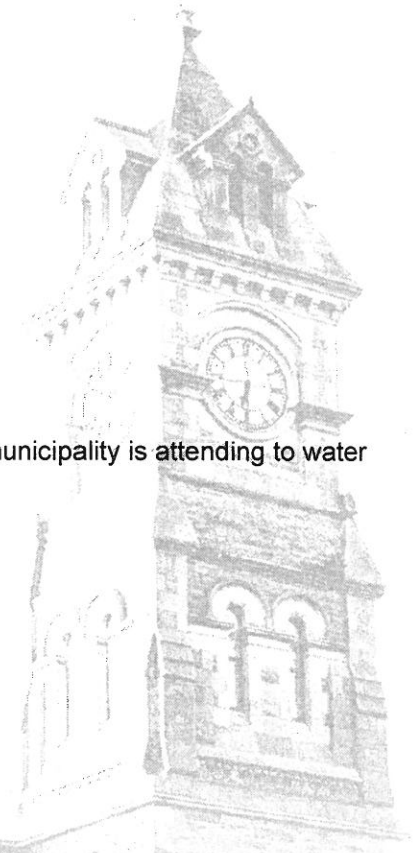
The work is expected to take a period four hours, starting from 09:00 AM to 13:00PM.
