



MAKANA LOCAL MUNICIPALITY

DEBT REDUCTION PAYMENT INCENTIVE SCHEME

The Makana Local Municipality has embarked on a debt reduction payment scheme to encourage residents to pay for municipal services. The Council meeting held on 30 January 2019 resolved to provide an incentive framework detailed below, within which qualifying debts of participants to the scheme will be written off in exchange for prompt, and timeous payments of future accounts rendered by the Municipality.

Eligibility for participation in the scheme is subject to terms and conditions as contained in the approved debt incentive scheme policy; applications received for participation in the scheme are to be received within the validity period of the scheme, which will commence on 1 February 2019 and will terminate on 30 June 2019.

The following incentives on cash settlements, and arrangements will be offered:

Residential consumers, commercial, agriculture, NPO's and Churches

120 days – 365 days	50%	50%
365 days and older	50%	50%
Interest(All)	70%	50%

The Municipality strongly urges all residents and consumers to take advantage of this limited time offer; participation in this scheme is aimed at providing the consumer a rare opportunity to both save money, and bring their municipal accounts into good standing, whilst providing much needed resources for the Municipality to improve the current service offerings within the community.


Effective 1 July 2019, Council will be adopting a zero tolerance campaign against all consumers who are in arrears for rates and service related charges; strict enforcement of the credit control and debt collection bylaw will culminate in the termination of services to site, and legal action being instituted for the recovery of all outstanding arrears.
