## PUBLIC NOTICE

### **JAMES KLEYNHANS WATER TREATMENT WORKS**

The filters at James Kleynhans Water Works need to be replaced. R1 million was availed from MISA for this purpose. Due to the fact that all the filters are not in operation, the waterworks is producing clean drinking water at half of its capacity. Consequently water will not be available in Makanda East all the time. Gift of the Givers will intensify water deliveries in Makanda East until the plant can produce at its full capacity. It will take two weeks to have the plant producing at its full capacity. The Gift of the Givers will deliver water today to the following points: Reebeick East, Scott's Farm, Vukani, Tantyi and Transit Camp. The delivery points will be communicated every day.

### **HOWIESONPOORT WATER TREATMENT PLANT**

The Howiesonpoort pump station is currently not operational. One of the pumps broke down and water leaking from this pump necessitated the shutdown of the pump station. The equipment at the pump station needs time to dry. The electricians are busy draining the water from the electric equipment. This might take two to three days.

An electrical control specialist EPM has been called in to do an assessment tomorrow. Industrial Blow heaters are being used to dry the equipment and the pumps.

There are some water in the lay dams at the Waainek Water Treatment Works that are being used to supply water to the Western side. Residents are therefore requested to use water sparingly - 25l/per day to a maximum of 4 people per household.

Residents are also urged not to connect water tanks to municipal supply, except for one tank to the maximum capacity of 2500 liters.

### **WINCANTON SUBSTATION**

The Wincanton substation has been vandalized again. Areas that receive power supply from the substation will have no power. The electricians are on site replacing the stolen parts. Power will be restored as soon as the repairs and replacements are done. A case of theft and damage to property has been open.

The municipality is trying everything to address the power and water challenges in order to curb interruptions and unacceptable water quality.

We call on the community to please report any vandalism of their property and the misuse of water. Please be patient as we are doing our best to attend to these unexpected occurrences.
