- Bidders must submit a valid SARS Tax status report <u>Issued with a Pin</u>; failure to submit will result in disqualification.
- Completed and signed declaration of interest MBD4, MBD 6.1, MBD 6.2, MBD 8 & MBD 9
- BBBEE Certificates original / certified copies must be submitted and failure to do so will result in loss of points.
- Original certified copy Directors/Owners/Partners Identity documents.
- A proposed project team, CV's of Directors and proof of relevant accreditation, must be submitted.
- Billing clearance certificate, lease agreement or statement of municipal accounts must be attached to and be returned with the tender documents
- Tenderers must be registered as a supplier/service provider on Makana Local Municipality supplier/service provider database <u>and</u> Central Supplier Database (CSD) proof of registration (Makana Database Confirmation Letter; CSD Registration report) on both databases must be submitted
- Failure to supply all mandatory documents will result in the tender being deemed non-responsive; and therefore the tender will not be considered for award.
- Tenders which are late, incomplete, unsigned or submitted by facsimile or electronically, will not be accepted.
- Documents to be filled with black ink.
- Tenders submitted are to hold good for a period of 90 days.

Received Responsive proposals will be evaluated based on the following two stages, namely:

- Stage 1 Functionality
- Stage 2 Price and Preferential Points

A bidder that scores less than 70 points out of 100 in respect of "functionality" will be regarded as submitting a non-responsive quote and will be disqualified and will be not evaluated further, i.e. for price. Only bidders who score 70 points or more would be evaluated further and therefore eligible for the award.
